If you are trying to get a hold of childcare after office hours please call the childcare cell phone at 608-219-8488 as they may be at playground or in the gym.

<u>CALENDAR CHANGE</u> – Eastside Lutheran's Pajama and Story Night originally scheduled for Friday, September 21st has been rescheduled for <u>Friday</u>, <u>October 1st at 6:30pm</u>. Please update your school calendar. Children ages 0-8 are welcome to come dressed in their favorite pajamas with pillows, blankets, or stuffed animals. Snuggle down and listen to stories read by Eastside Lutheran's teachers and a very special guest. You will also be able to end the evening with a bedtime snack. Please invite your friends!

FAST DIRECT SYSTEM- All Eastside families should be up and running with our Fast Direct System. If you don't have it established, please let the school office know. Fast direct is our hub of information website and is a great tool for communication. You will be able to view grades, add money to lunch and tuition accounts as well as class lists for your student(s) and parent contact info. You are able to email your teacher or any staff member at Eastside through Fast Direct. If you receive an email from your teacher through Fast Direct, a message will come to your regular email inbox stating that you have a message on Fast Direct and that you will have to log on to view it. The senders address will be noreply@fastdir.com. Please mark this as a safe contact. It is done this way to keep all email between teachers and parents secure. If you haven't logged on yet, please don't delay. You will find it to be your "go to" place for information regarding Eastside.

MEDICATION REMINDER – Eastside Lutheran School does not supply non-prescription drugs or pain relievers for student use. Any student requiring any type of non-prescription medication must have parental approval by filling out the Parent/Guardian Mediation Consent Form (found on Fast Direct) and bring the item from home. Please note that this includes cough drops and throat lozenges. All drugs or

medications must be turned in to the office. There is one exception, inhalers can be kept in the students backpacks, and epipens can be kept in the student's classroom. A form must still be completed by the parents and physician in order for those meds to be administered here at school.

Wisconsin statutes require that if and prescription or non-prescription drugs or medications are to be taken or administered at school, Eastside must have written authorization from the parent or guardian (many of you filled this out with our google registration form). The written authorization must include:

- The name of the medication
- Dosage
- The time of day the medication is to be administered
- The duration of time the medication is to be administered
- Signature of the physician or parent.

Pre-printed forms are also available from the school office.

Wisconsin statutes also require prescription and non-prescription drugs to come to school in their original pharmacy-labeled container or original manufacturer's packaging. Please make sure these containers are also labeled with your family name and contact information.



<u>BOX TOPS</u> – Box Tops are digital! Simply download the Box Tops app and scan your receipts. The app automatically finds your Box Top products and adds them into our school's total. Box Tops products will continue to have a special label identifying it as such. Another option is to submit the receipt with your name on it, and we will scan for you. Please note, receipts are only valid for 14 days after purchase. You can continue submitting clipped Box Tops as long as they're available in stores. Thank you for your continued help in making the Box Tops program a success for Eastside!

Online Scrip orders are placed on Mondays at 8:30am.

- Scrip orders will arrive by Friday of the same week and sent home in your child's backpack unless you specify differently.
- Scrip "On Hand" is available in the school office, every day, except Thursdays.
- Online scrip orders on Monday 9/6 will be submitted on Tuesday, 9/7 due to the Labor Day holiday.
