Step 4 - In the drop down for calendar year, choose the necessary year

Step 5 - Click Tax Year Printout

Step 6 - A new internet window will open with a tax report that they can print through their browser's print controls

Wisconsin Parental Choice Program online application opens Feb. 1

LLHS is part of the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP). For incoming freshmen and transfers selected to the WPCP, families can receive a voucher from the state of Wisconsin that pays Lakeside tuition. Families of 4 with household income up to \$65,300 are eligible. See all the details at llhs.org/choice
