3. Please inform Mr. Rank and the school office if your child is being tested for COVID-19.
4. If your child is being tested for COVID-19, he/she should stay home until the results of the test are known.
5. Please inform Mr. Rank and the school office of the results of the test.
6. When results of the test are known, Mr. Rank or Mrs. Paske will inform you of the next steps you will need to take.

Communication is an extremely vital part of the process of dealing with COVID-19 and keeping our children as safe and healthy as possible.
